Welcome message from Mr. Papa Sagna MBAYE, Minister of Fisheries and Maritime Economy

The International Sport Fishing Confederation has designated Senegal as the country to host the 31st world championship, paired with the African Sport Fishing Championship "Dakar 2023" from 11 to November 18, 2023.

This is because, twenty years ago, our country successfully hosted this championship both in terms of hosting and participation. Our A & B team came first and third on the table, winning gold and silver.

I would like to emphasize that our country was crowned world champion in Spain in 2002, after winning the silver medal in 2000 in Italy. There is nothing more telling than this record ,and for the second time, the Big Game Deep Sea Fishing World Championship will take place in Senegal. Following postponement due to the COVID19 pandemic, Dakar will host the 31st edition of this global event in November 2023.

Not only are our main activities linked to the sea, but Senegal has natural assets with 710 km of coastline, very productive ecosystems linked to "upwelling" phenomena, the upwelling of cold deep waters rich in mineral salts, giving Senegalese waters a rich and diverse fish fauna.

It is worth highlighting that in our country, fishing plays a very important socio-economic role and constitutes the first sector of the national economy as the main provider of foreign currency. It generates a lot of employment opportunities and provides an important part of the country's food security.

However, many constraints weigh on the marine environment characterized by the scarcity of fishery resources, the destruction of ecosystems and their habitats, the reduction of biodiversity, the loss of ocean ecological functions, the worsening of pollution, climate change and coastal erosion.

It is therefore an urgent necessity to act to protect the marine environment and to preserve its role as a contributor to the well-being of our people, particularly coastal communities whose existence remains closely linked to the good balance of the oceans.

Since Senegal hosted the national consultations on fisheries in 2000, our country has committed itself to preserving the marine environment, by carrying out bold reforms, through a cautious approach, consisting in observing periodic biological rest periods, establishing marine protected areas, immersing artificial reefs, promoting co-management, developing and implementing fisheries management plans.

The organization of an event like the Big Game Sport Fishing World Championship Deep Sea Fishing could not be done without effective preservation and protection actions for a balance of the marine environment and healthy oceans.

I take this opportunity to commend the immense work done by the Senegalese Sports Fishing Federation and its voluntary commitment to developing more than 1000 acres of submerged reefs.

In this regard, it is important to underline that my department has always involved the Federation as a partner in the definition and application of our fisheries policies.

To our dear competitors we already wish you good luck in the competition. We must spread the spirit of competition, and together meet the common challenges in protecting our marine ecosystem.

The Senegalese Sports Fishing Federation has been entrusted with hosting the 31st Big Game Trolling World Championships in 2023, following its track record of more than 15 participations in the world championships of sport fishing at sea since 1989, including an organization of the world championship in 2003 with a record of 2 gold medals, 1 silver and 2 bronze. This edition comes as a replacement to the 2020 event our country was to host and which had been canceled due to the global Covid pandemic.

The CPSD will make every effort to make these championships an enjoyable experience for all the delegation members, as well as a high-level sporting event.









REGULATIONS

The Big Game regulations as well as the 2022 and 2023 provisions can be downloaded from the FIPS-M website:

https://www.fips-m.org/statutes-rules-gb

Specific regulations:

Each participating nation may be represented by a maximum of 2 teams. Each team will be composed of 2 to 4 anglers. The release operation will be filmed by the team members.

In addition to the skipper, his possible assistant, the commissioner of fishing and the team of fishermen. Only the team captain can be onboard. However, an agent of the FIPS-M or of the organization may be present. Members of the press may be present at the organization's request.

The fish must be returned to the water by removing the hook if possible. If not, the leader must be cut 30 cm or less from the fish. All catches and releases must be video recorded. For validation purposes, the committee will distribute wristbands of different colours to all teams every morning of fishing for identification.

For capture and release of a fish to be validated, it is essential that the video reveals the following elements:

- That the fisherman has worn the wristband given out on the day,
- The species of fish caught,
- That a member of the team has touched the leader (identification using the wristband),
- That the clip has touched the end of the rod, or that the connection between the main line and the leader has passed through the end of the rod.

KEY ANTI-DOPING RECOMMENDATIONS

Athletes taking medicines are required to check whether they are on WADA's list of prohibited substances and methods.

Special precautions should be taken when taking antihypertensive drugs, especially diuretics, which are available both as individual preparations and in combination with other normally authorized medicinal products. Diuretics are still prohibited.

For these reasons, each athlete or national federation must check the list of prohibited substances and, if necessary, apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TEU). The therapeutic use exemption must be granted before taking a prohibited substance.

The Therapeutic Use Exemption must be submitted 30 days prior to participation in the championships. Application forms must be completed carefully and with your doctor's permission. A doctor's certificate or prescription does not in itself authorize the athlete to use the prohibited substance or method.

The application must be completed in English or French and sent directly to the office of the President of the CIPS.
